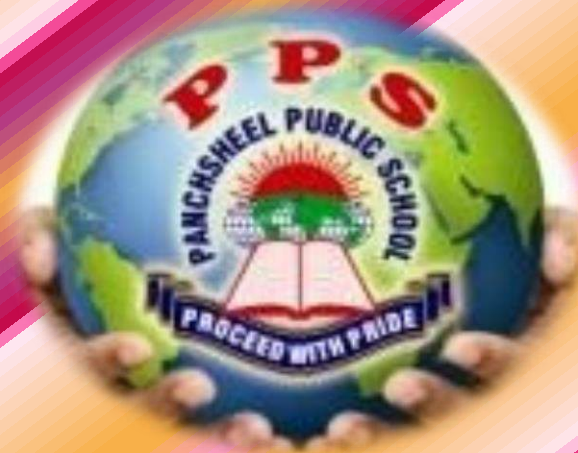

on wires and things.'

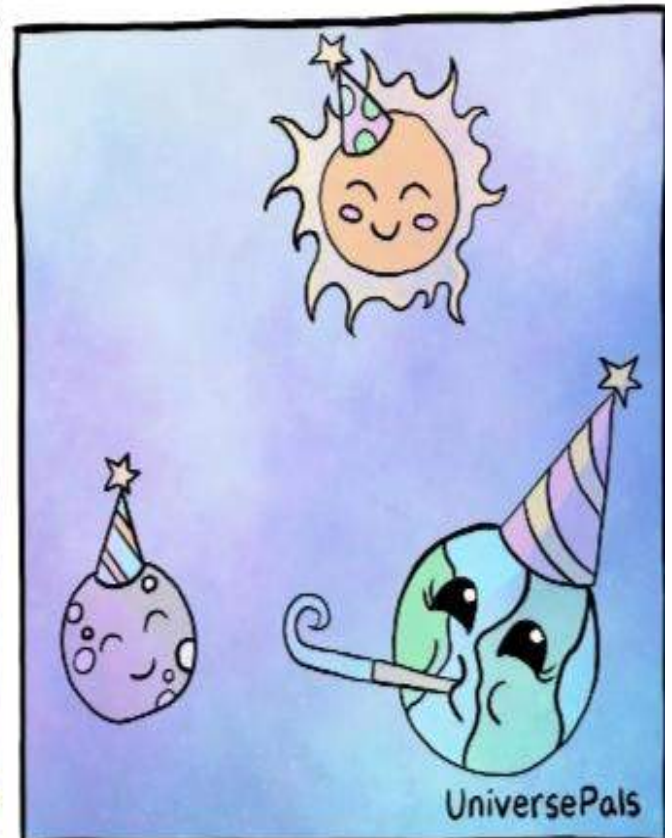
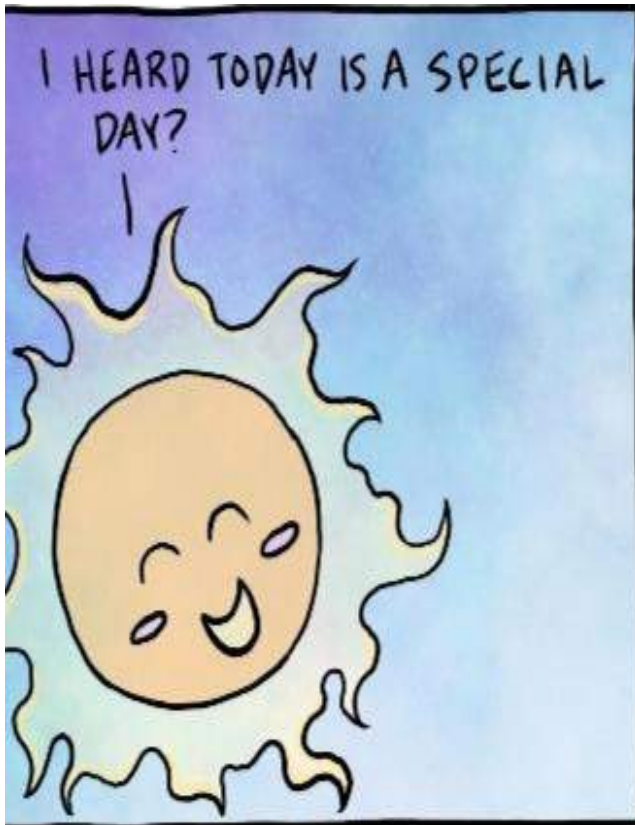
'Think!' said the robin.
