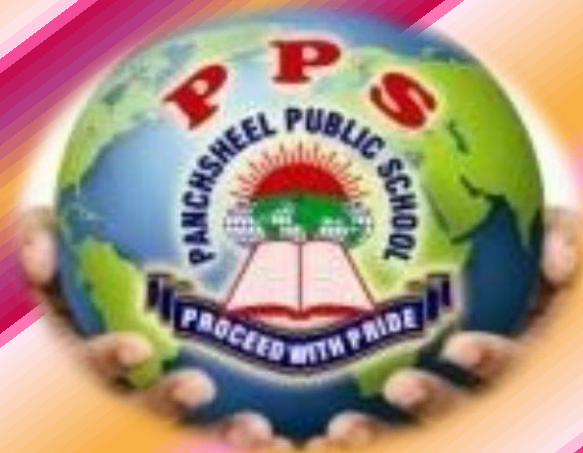

Step 2: Plant seedling

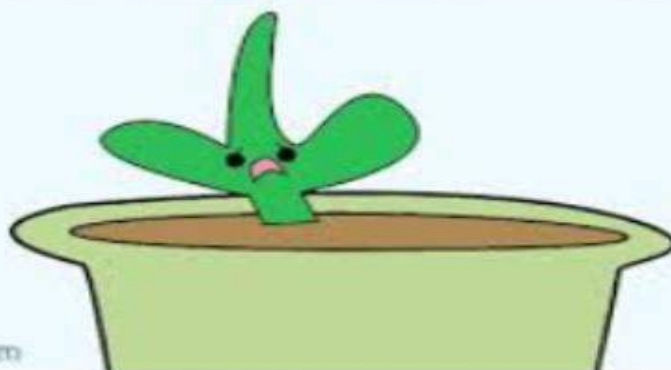


Step 3: Help seedling grow by talking to it
